WHAT IS A DPIA?

A DPIA is a questionnaire designed to help RPM identify, analyze, and minimize data protection and privacy risk.

What does a DPIA do?

- Documents how and why you collect personal data
- Records the types of personal data stored
- Considers the possible risk of harm to the people involved
- Examines possible alternatives to accomplish business objectives

When is a DPIA required?

Anytime you are considering a new tool, system or process that collects or uses personal data, or if you are making changes to an existing tool, system or process that affects personal data

Examples include:

- Procuring software that collects or stores, or interfaces with other software or systems that collect or store information about employees, customers or other individuals
- Updating a policy related to how you will handle or use collected from job applicants
- Signing an agreement with a vendor or service provider who will, or may, have access to personal data
- Implementing monitoring or tracking tools in the workplace or on the web including behavioral advertising or marketing features
- Creating, developing or updating processes or procedures that involve the collection of health or medical data
