Hot work is defined as any operation that involves open flames or produces heat or sparks.



Combustibles eliminated or otherwise safeguarded within 35-ft (11-m) of the work area.



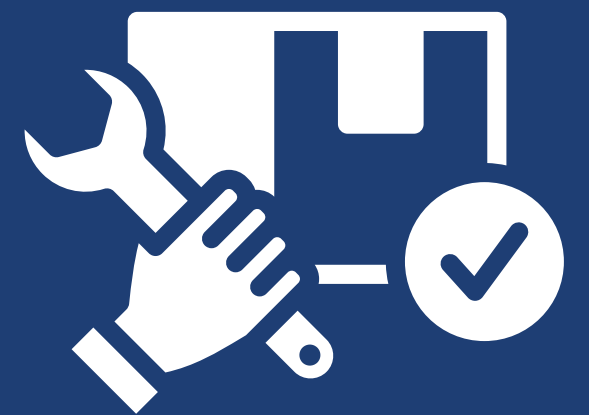
Floor penetrations properly protected.



Required fire protection, detection, and alarm systems are functional.



Hot work equipment in good repair.



Area monitored after completion for a period of one hour.



Dedicated fire watch during the operation



Adequate portable extinguishing equipment provided
